Given that many families are unexpectedly making Pesach at home this year, there is a higher demand than usual for use of the Keilim Mikveh. In order to ensure everyone's health and safety, we have established the following protocols.

- 1. Only one person/family should be in the Mikveh space at any given time. If someone is already there when you arrive, please wait in your car until they leave.
- 2. Immediately before coming to the Keilim Mikveh, please wash your hands with soap. We recommend that you also wash your hands with soap as soon as you get home.
- 2. Please wear gloves when toiveling your keilim. Gloves will be available at the Keilim Mikveh.
- 3. Please bring your own towels to dry off your keilim.
- 4. Please bring a garbage bag with you and remove any and all garbage you may have generated.
- 5. Disinfectant wipes, which can be used to disinfect door handles and the counter, will be available at the Keilim Mikveh.
- 6. Please remember that the Keilim Mikveh is open Sunday- Friday during daylight hours only.
