

Va'ad HaRabonim of Riverdale Eruv Map

- The borders of the eruv have changed over the years, generally due to expansion. However, circumstances may occasionally dictate contraction of the eruv. Please read your shul bulletin and shul mailings for announcements of any change which would affect the accuracy of this map and the associated notes.
- In case of great personal need or general public desire, it may be possible to expand the present eruv to include additional areas. Please consult with your rabbi for further guidance.
- There is a Kingsbridge eruv which is adjacent to the Va'ad HaRabonim of Riverdale eruv. It includes, roughly, the area between Riverdale Avenue and Broadway to the west and east, and between 230th and 240th Streets to the north and south. For further details about the Kingsbridge eruv, consult with your rabbi, or with Rabbi Crupar of the Kingsbridge Center of Israel.
